Application Status: NOT APPROVED

The permit application for a privacy fence has been denied for the following reason(s):

R1-B zoning requires a minimum five foot side yard setback. This means
the fence along Garden St. needs to set back six feet from the city sidewalk.
Inkster City Ordinance, Section 155.061K

Please submit a revised site plan that reflects zoning compliance.

The following are conditions to be met once the permit is approved:

- Post-hole inspections are required. Required post-hole depth is 36".
- Six feet (6') is the maximum height allowed for any residential fence.
- If an existing chain-link fence is on the property line, it cannot be removed without the neighbor's permission.
- The privacy fence cannot be attached to a chain-link fence.
- All structural elements of the fence must face inward ("pretty side out").
- If the privacy fence is installed inside the property line, the
 responsibility for abating vegetation growth between it and the
 chain link fence belongs to owner. Access into the intervening
 space is required to allow for mowing, weed-whipping, etc.
